

Paid Summer Externship

For Middle and High School Educators

Overview

The Educator Externship program, operated by the North State Building Industry Foundation, provides educators with **40 hours** of work experience in a construction or energy business. Educators learn first-hand how the subject they teach is relevant in the business world.

Eligibility

The opportunity is open to all middle and high school educators, including counselors.

Criteria for Completion

- Attend at a program orientation in spring
- Completion of 40 hours at a worksite
- Attend a 2-day lesson plan workshop in August
- Develop a lesson plan based on the experience
- Teach the lesson plan, and have students review it
- Attend the Show and Tell Reception with students

Counselors

The program has a separate track for counselors, which includes 40 hours of tours of post-secondary education options available in the Sacramento region. Instead of a lesson plan, counselors work together to produce some type of presentation of their experience for their peers.

Compensation

As the employer of record, the North State Building Industry Foundation covers the liability for the educator's time on the worksite.

Compensation for completion of the program is \$2,000, issued in two stipends.
